### NABE 2012 TEACHER OF THE YEAR deadline October 31, 2011

Candidates must be exceptionally skilled and dedicated teachers in a bilingual program in any grades from pre-Kindergarten through grade twelve. The winner of NABE's 2012 Bilingual Teacher of the Year competition will receive a \$2,500 scholarship to further his or her education or to use for the benefit of English language learners. In addition, travel expenses to the winner will be paid to go to the 2012 NABE conference in Dallas where the award will be presented.

### NABE 2012 DISSERTATIONS COMPETITION deadline October 31, 2011

The competition is open to those who have completed a dissertation in the field of bilingual education between December, 15 2010 and May 15, 2011. Three finalists will be selected for this award.

### NABE 2012 "BEING BILINGUAL" ESSAY CONTEST deadline October 31, 2011

English language learners in bilingual programs write an essay in English and in their native language on an experience related to being bilingual, using one of the following themes: Growing up Bilingual, Learning in Two Languages, Why I Want to be Bilingual, Proud to be Bilingual, The Power of Bilingualism, or My Future Bilingual Education Career. Two students will be selected.

**Cash Prizes**  
Grades 3-5: \$1,000 First Place Winner  
Grades 6-8: \$1,500 First Place Winner  
Two First Place student winners, along with their bilingual teacher and one parent or guardian, will receive an all-expense-paid trip to Dallas to attend the NABE Conference Awards Luncheon on February, 16, 2012
