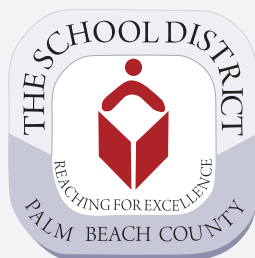

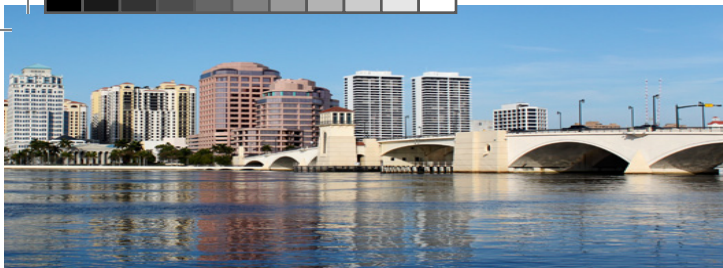

ABOUT OUR DISTRICT

The School District of Palm Beach County is the 5th largest school district in Florida and the 11th largest school district in the United States. We proudly educate more than 174,000 K-12 students who represent more than 110 nationalities and speak 150 languages/dialects. Our total budget of 2.3 billion dollars supports 186 regular schools (excluding 35 charter schools) and 21,361 employees, including 12,480 teachers. Since 2000, we have built 41 new schools and completely modernized 50 schools, many winning architectural and environmental awards.

We are an academically high performing district and a consistent leader among urban districts in the state. Twelve of our high schools are ranked among the top high schools in the nation by Newsweek and The Washington Post. Our 174 award-winning Career Academies and Choice Programs enroll more than 35,000 students. More than 38,591 community volunteers and 1,190 business partners provide academic assistance and resources to support increased student achievement.
