President's Initiatives in Bold.

- Pell Grants** - The President proposes in his FY 06 budget to add \$4.7 Billion in mandatory funding to retire the shortfall (\$4.3 billion) and increase the maximum award by \$100 increments over the next five years (for a total of \$420 million in FY 06).
- Perkins Loans Capital Contributions was eliminated in the FY 05 Omnibus Appropriations Bill, H.R. 4818 - H.Rept. 107-92
- The President proposes to eliminate the Upward Bound and Talent Search TRIO programs.
- The President proposes \$45 million for a pilot project to create Head Start block grants in 9 states.
